

CHORAL & ORCHESTRAL SPECTACULAR!

2010 sees Westbourne Orchestra celebrate its 80th birthday. The orchestra has already performed in a celebratory Prom Concert at the Royal Bath Hotel this year, which was a great success, and is due to perform again on Saturday 20th November at St Ambrose Church in Westbourne.

Joining the orchestra will be 150 singers from Blandford Choral Society and University Choral Society as they perform Beethoven's "Choral" Symphony (No.9), which contains the well known theme "Ode To Joy". The ensemble will also be paying tribute to bi-centenary of the town of Bournemouth by performing the Bournemouth Anthem, "Our Bournemouth", written by Douglas Eyre, with music composed by Paul Rissmann (the BSO's resident composer). Douglas Eyre will be in attendance to hear what may be the final performance of the anthem in this Bournemouth's Bi-Centenary Year.

The orchestra will also be performing Mozart's "Magic Flute" overture and Zadok the Priest.
